Survey results from Volunteers Returning and Volunteer Roles During COVID – 19

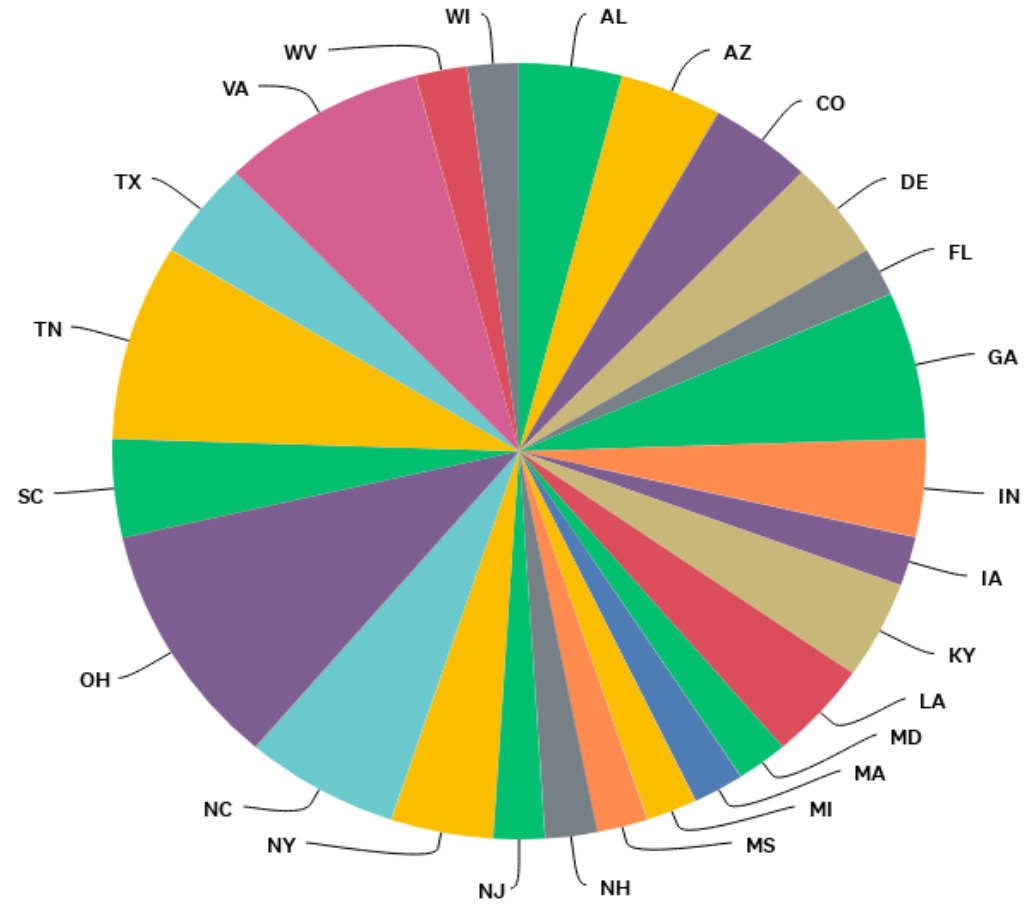
January 7, 2021 through February 22, 2021

- There were 25 states represented in the survey results.



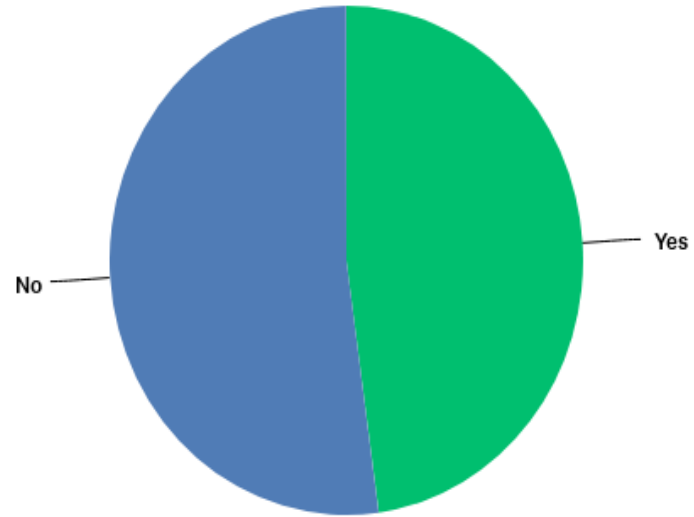
Which state/region

represented.



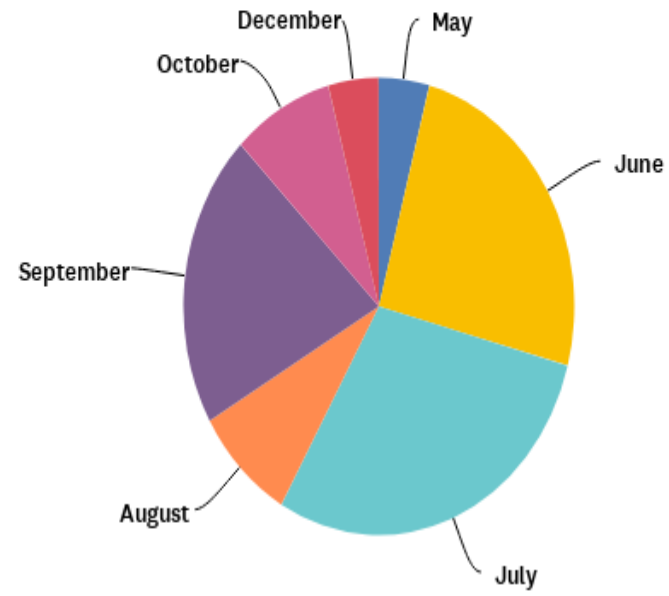


Q4 Have your volunteers returned?

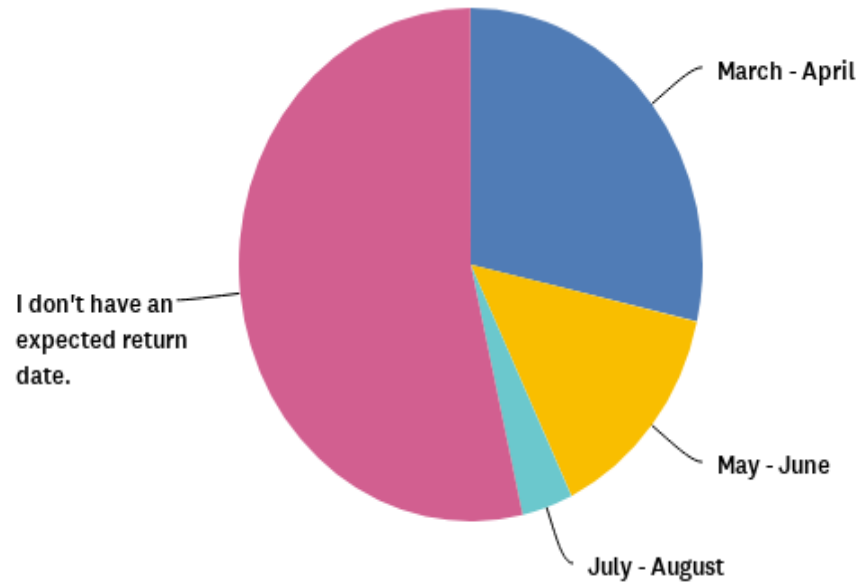




Q5 If you answered yes to question 4 when did they return?



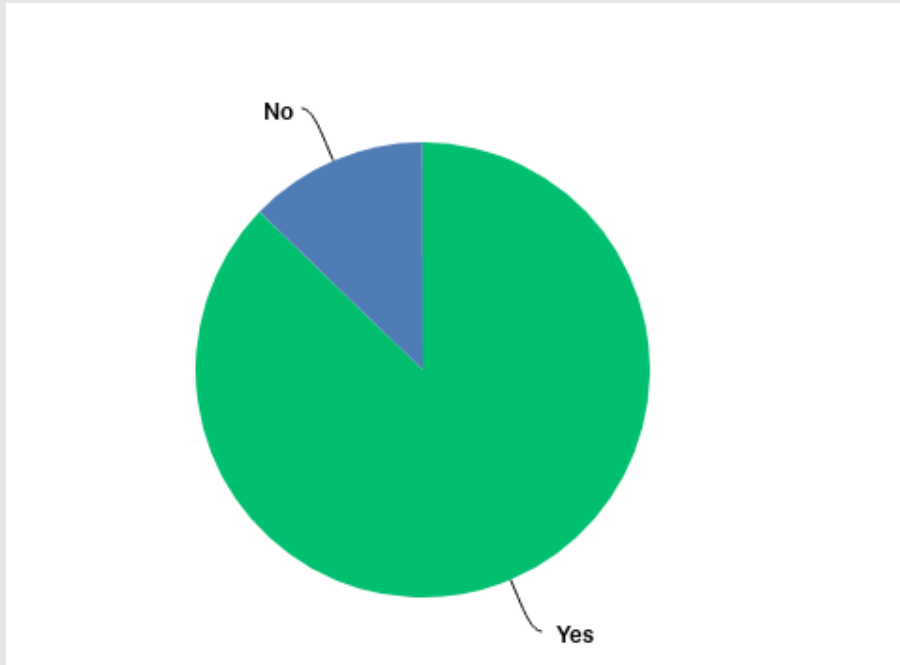
Q6 If you answered no to question 4 what is your expected return date?



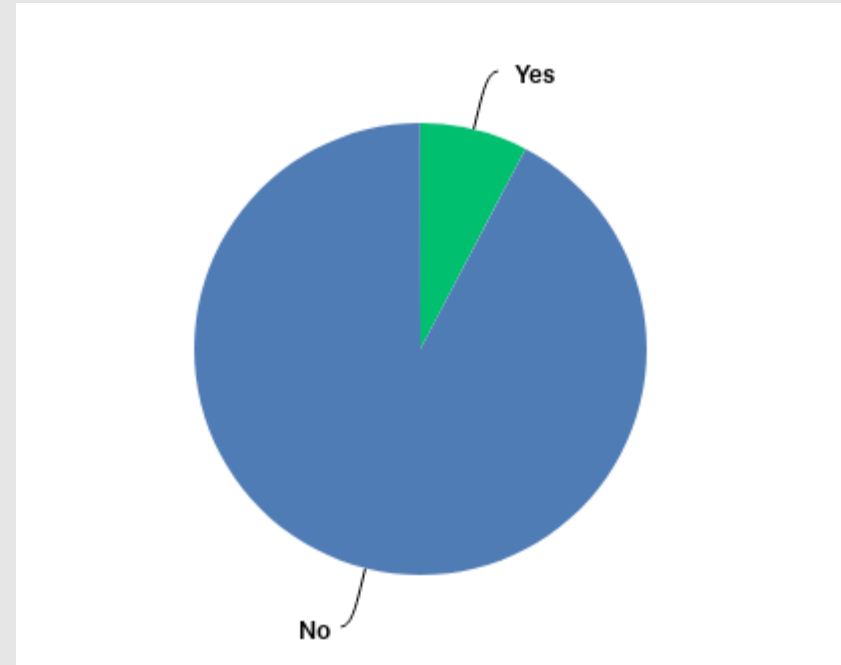


VACCINE the hot topic of 2021!

- Did you offer the vaccine to your volunteers?

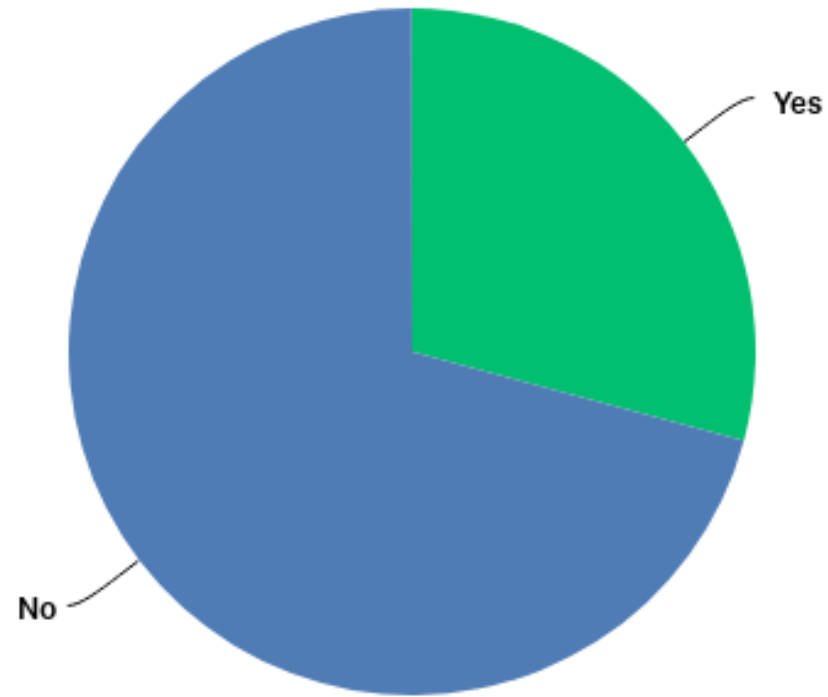


- If you answered yes to question 7, were the vaccines mandatory?

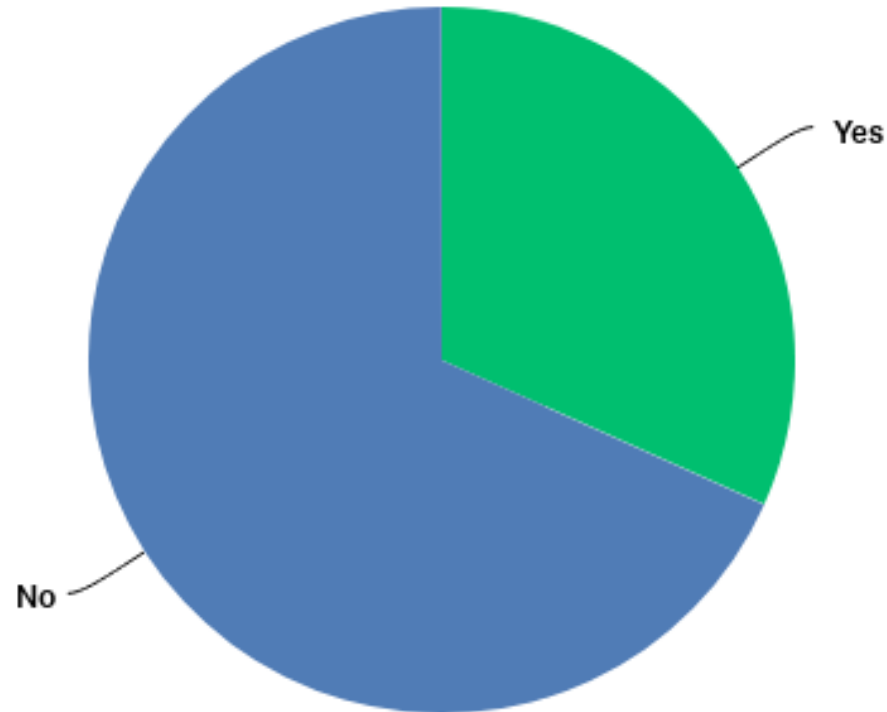

1	The volunteers that returned in October 2020 are only in non-clinical areas and a total of 25. Also have 5 volunteers working virtually (clerical duties).	2/17/2021 8:50 AM
